Photography Contest/Exhibition Guidelines

Submission guidelines:

1. Participants can submit at most 3 entries for juried selection, one in each category.
2. All entries have to be submitted electronically onto the Hum Sub website.
3. Each file must be in jpeg format with file size limited to 20 MB.
4. Minimum resolution of each submission is 300 dpi, preferably 1600 x 2000 pixels in size.
5. The contest is open for entry submission, as of Monday, June 13, 2016.
6. Deadline for entry submission is midnight, Saturday, September 10, 2016.
7. All participants will be informed of the jury's decision (acceptance/rejection) by Saturday, October 1, 2016, by email.
8. All photograph submitted for entry in the contest must have been taken by the person on the entry form after January 1, 2011.

Rules:

1. Photographs should align with the theme and category of the contest.
2. Photo contest is open to anyone residing in the State of North Carolina, except for individuals and families of Hum Sub Board and Advisors.
3. No differentiation will be made between amateur or professional photographers.
4. There is no age categorization or limit. Everyone (youth or adult) is treated the same.
5. There is no entry fee to the contest.

6. Photo entries may be in color or black & white.
7. All selected photographs will be printed by Hum Sub and prepared for display.
8. Judging will occur before Cary Diwali (Oct 15, 2016).
9. The judging panel shall determine winner eligibility in its sole and absolute discretion.
All decisions made by the judges are final.
10. Winners will be awarded prizes.
11. Participants must pick up their printed photographs on Saturday, October 15, 2016 (in-person at the exhibition tent between 8 PM- 9 PM on October 15, 2016).
12. After October 15, 2016, all unclaimed photograph submissions will be destroyed, unless a special request is made to exhibition@humsub.net before October 1, 2016.
