The Town of Cary/Booth Amphitheatre agrees to provide the following:

- Ground covering
- Vending tent (each food vendor will get a 10x20 food prep/vending area
- Cooking tent
- 6-8 6' tables
- General lighting (does not include lighting under the tent)
- Electricity (does not include power strips/drop cords)
- Potable water
- Grey water tank

Food vendors are responsible for the following:

- Submitting Wake County Temporary Food Establishment Vendor Application and fee by due date
- All equipment related to food storage, preparation/cooking, serving and selling
- Under tent lighting and power strips/drop cords
- Cleaning up vending area

Specific Event Details:

- Food vendors can ONLY sell Pepsi products in 20 oz. plastic bottles. Drinks prices are \$4. **Drinks cannot be sold for less.**
- Food vendor fees and damage deposit must be collected prior to the event. The damage deposit will only be deposited if the following occurs: physical damage to Town/Booth Amphitheatre property (including rental property), vending violations, food disposal violations or excessive cleaning.
- Food vendors must be completely setup and ready when their inspection begins.
- Food vendors must stop selling food by 9 p.m.

I understand and agree to follow the stated rules and regulations. If I break any of the above rules, I understand that I will be asked to leave the venue and my damage deposit will not be returned. No warning may be given prior to being asked to leave the venue.
